EXCURSION: FOREST-BASED BIOECONOMY

Date: 9–10 July 2019 Location: Äänekoski Departing: 9 July, Train Helsinki–Jyväskylä (departure 19.04, arrival 22.27) Returning: 10 July, Train Jyväskylä–Helsinki (departure 19.17, arrival 22.54)

This excursion will take us to Äänekoski, in central Finland. We will visit Pro Nemus, which is Metsä Group's visitor centre, where we will be introduced to a cross-section of their operations, products and opportunities offered by the bioeconomy. We will also have a chance to visit Metsä Fibre, the first next-generation bioproduct mill in the world. In the afternoon, we will be introduced to bioeconomy solutions of Valio (cheese production) and CP Kelco, a global leader in the manufacturing of specialty hydrocolloids. Later, we will visit a forest site, where Metsä Group will present how it ensures sustainable management and growth of forests and protects forest nature diversity. Our visit to Äänekoski ends in beautiful Kapeenkoski, which offers sustainable tourism services.

The trip to Äänekoski requires an overnight stay. Participants are responsible for the costs of accommodation and should book their accommodation themselves. Our hotel is Spa Hotel Peurunka (<u>https://peurunka.fi/en/</u>). You should book your accommodation by 11 May, by phone +358 20 7516 300, or by email peurunka@peurunka.fi. Remember to give the reservation code EU-BIO 9.–10.7.19 when you book your reservation to get the pre-agreed price. The cost of the accommodation for the night is EUR 92.
